



## Work Permit Instructions for PYSC parents

Referees under the age of 18 are required to obtain a work permit in order to be a PYSC Referee.

Work permits are issued by your high school's Guidance office. Work permits must be requested by a parent or legal guardian. Your child does not need to be present when you obtain a permit. Please gather the following items before you go in for child's permit.

- Letter of intent, available on the PYSC website. Signed and dated.
- Your Childs Birth Certificate
- Your Childs Social Security Number
- \$10

These items are state requirements and the school may not issue a permit if any piece of information is missing. The letter of intent is to be left with the school. Your child's birth certificate will be verified and will go back home with you.

Once you have obtained a permit, it must be turned in to the Chief Referee with your referee registration form. Please mail these two documents to the below address. They cannot be assigned games until PYSC has your permit.

This work permit is good for your entire employment with PYSC and you are **not** required to get a new one each year.

Once your child has refereed 6 games with zero no-shows, the \$10 permit fee will be reimbursed.
